married at the age of 15 and 48% got married at the age of 16 &17. Married 15% of them are physically and mentally not fit for the frequency. Once we consider their level of education out of forty mothers we identified thirty one mothers have studied up to grade 8 and 10. The other 9 of them studied up to Advance level. Majority of them have low level of education. This situation dings a bad impact for their families, society as well as the growth of national economy. These below eighteen mothers are unable to perform their duties for their children. This is a kind of arguable condition. teenage mother take responsibility of their family?

When considering their marriage life 25% of them have been married according to their parent's aspiration. Our discussion elaborates of parents influenced to get marry their teenage daughters. When we concern about the economical conditions of the teenage mothers' majority of them comprise low income. There are 75% families earn less than Rs. 10,000 per month. In this families their income is depend on their husband's profession but that also not permanent. This makes poor.

According to analysis the main impacts of the teenage, marriages are their background, low income, family unstable community, uneducated parents and children. It is clear that unstable community is one of the causes of children becoming teenage mother. Not only unstable community but also parents go out to earn money. The distance between parents and children, close friendship, their family background, persuasion of Media also growing teenage causes for the

mothers. Poor cultural influences are major root cause for this. These families have been lived during the post war period. As the ruins of war it makes culturally broken minded people.

When a teenage girl who was not ready physically and mentally to be pregnant she has to face lot of obstacles. This situation effects the sentimental of their life as well marriage trustworthiness between the parties. These families have to be educated form the grass root level. It is time to take some responsibilities of parents. children through their teachers' as well as the media. They can motivate their children by teaching the importance of having a good education.

Sex education is the most important concept and by this we can remove some negative attitudes of students. Child personalities can be developed through the education. Through the women empowerment and awareness programme help to develop the self confidences of teenage mothers. It is worth to blend the children with the society to avoid that kind of social problems. It provides the major path to thev build once children personalities their though own experiences.
