Additionally, the study analyzes the use of tropes such as the month of March, pastoral elements, and diction of fairytales, which further contribute to the narrator's nostalgia and cultural associations. The novel's poetic structure, including auditory and visual imagery, creates a cinematic quality, allowing readers to vividly experience the narrator's recollections. The symbolic significance of train sounds and whistles underlines the transient nature of life and memories. Ultimately, the findings indicate that the linguistic and poetic structures in Bringing Tony Home are intertwined and inseparable, effectively manifesting the theme of nostalgia for the past, and presenting readers a prevailing vision into the profound form-content relationship within the text.
