SDG 01: No Poverty





The University Business Linkage Cell (UBLC) of Rajarata University of Sri Lanka (RUSL) successfully completed phase IV evaluation on 12th of January 2023 at University Premises. The RUSL UBLC is the sixth national University to complete the Phase 04 evaluation administered by the AHEAD Unit of University Grant Commission. UBL has presented all completed actions under the phase IV with strong evidences and the general progress of the UBL for the future sustainability. All AHEAD grant winners also presented the progress and outcomes achieved in the research

projects. For successful on time completion of the UBLC Phase 04, the RUSL UBLC will be granted an additional 02 million rupees to carry out its functions smoothly. Mr. Prasanna S. Ekanayake, Attorney-at-Law, E W Associated and Mr. Sanjeewa Gunawardena, Executive Director, E B Creasy & CO PLC, Darley Butler & Co Ltd, Laxapana Bateries PLC were joined as a evaluators of the phase 04 evaluation along with AHEAD Lead academic Professor Thusitha Abeytunga. The Vice Chancellor of Rajarata University of Sri Lanka, Prof. (Mrs) G.A.S. Ginigaddara delivered the welome speech and Dr.Manoj Samarathunga, the Director University Business Linkage Cell presented the progress of the UBLC. The event was also graced by the presence of Deans, the Librarian, Head of Departments, Professors, Directors of University Centers, Directors of the North Central Province Chamber of Commerce and Commercial partners etc.

In the Scimago ranking of Sri Lankan universities in 2023, Rajarata University is placed second in the research percentile and second-best for overall research performance. For the institute to be ranked, at least 100 Scopus publications must be published within the given year. According to the research percentile, RUSL researchers published 162 research articles in 2022, helping the institution to be recognized as the second-best university in Sri Lanka. archers that are affiliated with RUSL participated.

On March 14, 2023, Dr. Selim Buyrukoglu, a lecturer at Ankara Karatekin University with a focus on artificial intelligence (computer science), paid a visit to the faculty of technology at Rajarata University of Sri Lanka. The Rajarata University of Sri Lanka and Cankiri Karatekin University of Turkey collaborated on the **Erasmus+ Programme's** Key Action 1: Higher Education Student and Staff Mobility Inter-Institutional Agreement 2022–2028 to make this trip possible. This is the first international mobility as per the MOU signed after establishing the University International Relations Unit. During his visit, an interactive workshop on employing hybrid machine-learning methods for numerical data analysis was held with the staff and students. In addition, he discussed

the results of his artificial intelligence research and the viability of transferring those results to other areas of study. Throughout this visit, he has taken part in a number of conversations in small groups with the faculty and students. Also, discussions on potential future partnerships with regard to research and teaching at both Universities were also had. With 85 attendees, the workshop was a smashing success.





"Varsity Battles Capital Market Quiz Competition" took place at the Rajarata University of Sri Lanka on 24th May 2023. 
Project Hope

SDG 04: Quality Education



New Building Complex for CDCE

On January 20, 2023, Rajarata University officially opened a newly built structure for the Center for Distance and Continuing Education

(CDCE) with the participation of Senior Professors Sampath Amarathunge, Chairman, and Chandana P. Udawatte, Vice Chairman, University Grants Commission. The RUSL administration was represented by Royal Pandith Eethalawatunuwewe Gnanathilake Thero, Chancellor, Professor (Mrs.) G.A.S. Ginigaddara,

Vice Chancellor, all of the Deans of Faculties, the Acting Registrar, Acting Bursar, Director/CDCE, and other officials. The CDCE/ RUSL offers UGC approved study programs for three external degrees, four diplomas, and three certificates to meet the needs of adult students who are pursuing further education but are not accepted to universities. Over 4500 pupils are currently served by the center. In order to



serve a larger number of knowledge seekers in the nation, the CDCE was erected and relocated to the city of Anuradhapura in 2012. It was initially established on the grounds of Mihinthale. Through this center, which serves both the requirements of the community and the needs of business, the university anticipates offering more cutting-edge programs for professional and academic growth in 2023. 




Abstract Journal Article: Simulating flexibility, variability and decentralisation with an integrated energy system model for Great Britain


Energy system models allow the development and assessment of ambitious transition pathways towards a sustainable energy system.

Energy system models allow the development and assessment of ambitious transition pathways towards a sustainable energy system. However, current models lack adequate spatial and temporal resolution to capture the implications of a shift to decentralised energy

supply and storage across multiple local energy vectors to meet spatially variable energy demand. There is also a lack of representation of interactions with the transport sector as well as national and local energy system operation. Here, we bridge these gaps with a highresolution system-of-systems modelling framework which is applied to Great Britain to simulate differences between the performance of decarbonised energy systems in 2050 through two distinct strategies, an electric strategy and a multi-vector strategy prioritising a mix of fuels, including hydrogen. Within these strategies, we simulated the impacts of decentralised operation of the energy system given the variability of wind and across flexibility options including demand side management, battery storage and vehicle to grid services. Decentralised operation was shown to improve operational flexibility and maximise utilisation of renewables, whose electricity supplies can be costeffectively converted to hydrogen or stored in batteries to meet peak electricity demands, therefore reducing carbon-intensive generation and the requirement for investment in expanding the electricity transmission network capacity. 
